## Background

Dagana Dzongkhag is located in the southern part of the country. It covers an area of 1389 Sq. Km, with an elevation ranging from 600 to 3800 meters above the sea level. About 83 percent of the Dzongkhag is under forest cover. It has a total projected population of 25,070, out of which 12,644 are male and 12,427 are female as of 2010.

Dagana is bordered by Thimphu and Chukha Dzongkhag in the West, Wangdue Dzongkhag in the north, Tsirang Dzongkhag in the East and the Indian State of West Bengal in the South. The Dzongkhag falls within the temperate and sub-tropical zone with hot and wet summer and dry cold winter.

The Dzongkhag has one Dungkhag, that is, Lhamoizingkha and 14 Gewogs viz. De-orali, Lhamoizingkha, Nichula, Dorona, Drujegang, Gesarling, Goshi, Kana, Khe-bisa, Lajab, Tashiding, Tsendagang, Tsangkha and Tseza. The Dzongkhag has two constituencies viz. Drujeygang-Tseza Constituency and Lhamoizingkha-Tashiding Constituency.

Most settlements are remote and do not have road connectivity. This combined with the rugged terrain makes the delivery of services difficult and costly. The Dzongkhag has 8 BHUs, 23 Schools supplemented by Extended Class Rooms and Out Reach Clinics.

Agriculture farming is the main source of income of the Dzongkhag. The climatic conditions are favorable for growing different types of crops such as paddy, maize, millet, mandarin, cardamom, banana, passion fruit, pear, avocado, and vegetables such as broccoli, cauliflower, cabbage, potato, chilies, and tomatoes.

Dagana is a historically significant Dzongkhag in that it served as the seat of Daga Penlop and later as Daga Dzongpon for many years. It has many secret sites and monuments such as Daga Tashi Yangtsi, Do Namkhai Kaw, Do Kelpai Goenthay and Tha Namkhai Dzong , Do Phamai Nye, Do Dungchen Menchu, Do Dungkar and Wachen Nye .
