## Background

Thimphu is the capital of Bhutan. It shares boundaries with Gasa and Punakha Dzongkhags in the east, Chukha and Dagana in the south, Paro Dzongkhag in the west and Tibet (China) in the north.

The Dzongkhag has one Dungkhag and 8 Gewogs viz; Chang, Dagala, Genyekha, Kawang, Mewang, Lingzhi, Naro and Soe. Mewang, Chang, Dagala, Genyekha and Kawang Gewogs falls directly under the Dzongkhag Administration while the 3 Gewogs of Lingzhi, Naro and Soe are under the Lingzhi Dungkhag Administration. It has many important historical, cultural and religious heritage sites.

Thimphu Dzongkhag is also considered as one of the developed Dzongkhags in the country. The lower part of the Dzongkhag has an easy access to the national referral hospital, national research centers, central ministries, agriculture related corporations and the financial institutions. With the capital being located in the Dzongkhag, it is predominant economic and trading hub for the Western region. Therefore, it provides large domestic market for the agricultural and livestock products.

The Dzongkhag has a total of 41 Schools, out of which 7 are Community Primary Schools, 6 Primary Schools, 9 Lower Secondary Schools, 4 Middle Secondary Schools and 2 Higher Secondary Schools, 13 private schools and 38 NFE Centres . The Dzongkhag has covered 95% of the households with electricity including solar light in Lingzhi Drungkhag.

An extension services such as agriculture, livestock and forestry are available in all Gewogs. The Dzongkhag had reduced agricultural land due to urbanization. Rapid growth rates in rural-urban migration has resulted the increase in unemployment and population of the Thimphu city.
