Background

Trongsa Dzongkhag is located in the heart of the country. It covers an area of 1807 Sq. Km with an elevation ranging from 800 meters to 4,800 meters above mean sea level.

The total projected population for the Dzongkhag in 2009 was 14,448 with an annual growth rate of 1.4 percent. is the Dzongkhag is bordered by Bumthang Dzongkhag in the northeast, Wangdue Dzongkhag in the west and Zhemgang Dzongkhag in the south.

Trongsa Dzongkhag has five Gewogs viz; Drakteng, Korphu, Nubi, Langthil and Tangsibji. Among the five, Nubi Gewog is one of the most densely populated Gewogs in the Dzongkhag. The Dzongkhag has two Constituencies: Nubi- Tangsibji and Drakteng- Langthil.

Despite rugged terrain, the East-West lateral highway and the Trongsa-Gelephu highway passes through Trongsa connecting almost all the Gewogs in the Dzongkhags by motorable roads. Though the East-West and Bumthang-Gelephu lateral highways passes through the Dzongkhag, most of the settlements are still remote due to lack of feeder roads. However, every Gewog in the Dzongkhag has a BHU, RNR centers and a School each. Agriculture farming is the main source of income for majority of the population. Farmers grow almost all kinds of crops but in some areas potatoes are the main source of cash income.

There are many sacred monuments like tapering rock in Nubji lakhang, Kubra,Ugen Drak and Phumzur lhakhang, which is believed that Guru Padmasambhava have visited and meditated in this sacred sites on his way back from Trongsa to India in 8th century. The other sacred spots in Trongsa are Ta-Dzong, and Trongsa Dzong that lulls immense attraction for tourist.

Jigme Singye Wangchuck National Park that covers an area of 1,723 Sq. km is a home for many globally endangered rare floras and fauna of the country, and it's a habitual place for one of the most globally endangered species Golden Langur.
