

Background

Wangdue Dzong was founded by Zhabdrung Ngawang Namgyal in 1638. It is located on a high ridge between the Puna Tsang Chu and the Dangchu, It is located in the western Bhutan and is bordered by Punakha in the north, Thimphu in the west, Trongsa in the east and Tsirang in the south. It has an area of about 4308 Sq. km with an elevation ranging from 800 meters to 5800 meters above the sea level.

Wangdue Dzongkhag has fifteen Gewogs viz; Athang, Bjena, Daga, Dangchu, Gangtey, Gasetshog Gom, Gasetshog Wom, Kazhi, Nahi, Nyisho, Phangyul, Phobjikha, Rubeisa, Sephu & Thedtsho.

The projected population of Wangdue is 34,320 in 2010 with 17605 males and 16714 females. About 65 percent of its total land area is under forest cover, which consists of both broadleaf and conifers. Phobjikha Gewog is famous for the winter roosting place for the black necked cranes. The scenic beauty offered by the wide expanse of Phobjikha combined with habitation of the endangered black necked cranes has attracted hosts of enthusiasts ranging from researchers, scientists, conservationist, students, nature lovers and tourist. The adjoining Jigme Dorji Wangchuck National Park extends into the northern part of the Dzongkhag and covers nearly 4 Gewogs inclusive of Phojikha and Gangtey. The acclaimed monastery, Gangtey Goenpa, is located in this valley under Gangtey Gewog and the well known site for pilgrimage of Boed Langdra is in Kazhi Gewog.

Chuzhing dominates the agricultural activity, followed by Kamzhing, mixed farming. Paddy fields are mostly along the Dangchu and Puna Tsang Chu, with double cropping of rice as an important agricultural feature. Paddy is the most popular cereal grown in the lower valleys while potato is the most important cash crop for the Gewogs of Phobji, Gangtey and Sephu. Citrus is increasingly becoming popular in the Gewogs of Daga, Bjena, Phangyul and Rubeisa while ginger is extensively produced in Daga and Athang Gewogs as a source for generating income. The lower valley towards the southern belt is also suitable for sub-tropical horticulture crops such as mangoes, pineapples, litchis, guavas.
